17th batch of PGP begins at IIM Indore

The chief guest of the event, Mr. Janakiraman held an open house with the participants on *Mid Career Transition Challenges.* Drawing lessons from his own personal experience of transitioning from a manager at Wipro to founding member of Mindtree to investor & founding member of a cloud computing startup, Mr. Janakiraman articulated ten tradeoffs that are likely to be made during such transitions. The key tradeoffs included; distance versus displacement, depth versus breadth and high tech versus low tech.

Professor Jayasimha shared the value proposition of the EPGP, programme structure, international immersion at McCombs School of Business, University of Texas Austin and other details as part of his address.

Mr. Siddhartha Roy, Economic Advisor to DES, Tata Economic Think Tank

As a part of the on-going Economic Lecture Series Mr. Siddhartha Roy delivered a lecture on *India's Bilateral and Regional Trade Arrangements* and the likely Impact of the Trans-Pacific Agreement on India at the Institute on Friday, September 5, 2014.

His insightful lecture covered the three levels of global trade policy and arrangements. He briefly discussed the new developments in the global trade arrangements and how it is affecting Indian economy.

Mr. Roy is Economic Advisor to the Department of Economics and Statistics (DES), Tata Economic Think Tank and Research Group since December 2003. He holds a doctorate in Economics from IIM Ahmedabad.



To sensitize the members of the IIM Indore community about various implications of eradicating power problems with the use of renewable sources of energy in diverse parts of rural India, IIM Indore organized a lecture by Mr. Anshuman Lath, Director, Gram Oorja Solutions Private Limited, Pune at the Institute on August 20, 2014. The lecture was attended by

the faculty, staff and students of the Institute.

In an hour-long session, Mr. Lath explained the electrification problems prevalent in the rural areas of India and the possible solutions to it by means of renewable sources of energy such as sun, water and bio-gas. He elaborated upon the influence of the political economy of the country on rural electrification and how power stealth affects the official power supply in the rural areas.

Legal experts, representing Jwala, also explained the rights and relaxations given to women when their safety is in danger. The workshop concluded with the demonstration of basic martial arts that women can practice to fight against violence and sexual harassment.

Mr. Dave shared valuable insights on various push and pull mechanisms in the US energy markets that boost the viability of wind and solar energy so that they can be project financed. Some of the mechanisms, he shared, were tax equity partners, accelerated depreciation, renewable energy credits (REC) markets, flip structures, renewable portfolio standards and regulatory aspects related to the clean energy projects. He discussed the structures of Holding company and LLC (Limited Liability Company) that owns the renewable energy assets & contracts. He also discussed risk mitigation, sculpting of Debt Service to match the project cash flows and lenders' concerns in financing such projects.
