## **Conference, Workshop and Lectures**

#### ICISRT-2014

The two-day International Conference on Information Systems Research and Teaching (ICISRT) - 2014 was organised at IIM Indore during December 22-23, 2014.

On the first day, Professor Rishikesha T. Krishnan, Director, IIM Indore, welcomed the eminent speakers and participants of the conference and elaborated on its theme. The principal objective of the conference was to provide a platform to the researchers, faculty members and managers /practitioners for interaction amongst each other and stay abreast with the recent developments in information systems and technology.

The keynote addresses of the conference were delivered by Mr. Avinash Vashistha, Chairman and Geography Managing Director, Accenture India and Professor Ramesh Sharda, Director of the Institute for Research in Information Systems (IRIS), Spears School of Business.

While Mr. Avinash Vashistha discussed the future trends of Information Technology (IT) such as SMAC (Social, Mobile, Analytics and Cloud) integration, crowd sourcing, architecting resilience and designing IT for analytics, along with their impact on business, Professor Ramesh Sharda, highlighted the role of business analytics and how it will impact business in future. On the second day, a panel discussion was held on the theme, Evolution of Information Systems Research & Teaching in India in Last Two Decades.

The panel comprising of Professor Bharat Bhasker, Faculty, IIM Lucknow; Professor Venkata Rao V., Faculty, IIM Ahmedabad and Professor Rajendra K. Bandi, Faculty, IIM Bangalore, discussed the role of Information Technology and its transformation in the last two decades.

Professor Rajhans Mishra, Faculty, IIM Indore and convener of the conference, spoke about the papers presented during the conference by Professor Satish Krishnan, Assistant Professor, IIM Kozhikode; Professor Arunabha Mukhopadhyay, Faculty, IIM Lucknow and Professor Sumeet Gupta, Faculty, IIM Raipur.













#### Professor Rishikesha T. Krishnan Speaks on 8 Steps to Innovation

Professor Rishikesha T. Krishnan, Director, IIM Indore, interacted with the members of Young Indians, an integral part of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), during a lecture on *Innovation* at IIM Indore on December 9, 2014. More than 30 members of the Young Indians group attended the interactive session to discuss different ways in which they can execute innovative ideas to solve their organizational problems resulting in benefits to the users.

In his insightful lecture, Professor Krishnan discussed the key points of the book 8 Steps to Innovation, authored by himself and Dr. Vinay Dabholkar, to explain various steps to create innovation in a company. Beginning from its basic definition, he went on to explain various types of innovation, the entire process of innovation and how each step in it plays a vital part in the development of an organization.








#### Panel Discussion on Innovation Challenges

The Special Group on Frugal and Inclusive Innovation at IIM Indore brought together a diverse group of innovators for a panel discussion on *Innovation Challenges* at the Institute on December 20, 2014. The speakers profile ranged from an individual innovator to senior executives from SMEs and large corporate houses.





While Mr. Rajendra Jain spoke about his innovative financing method, Ms. Rekha Kadam discussed the development of a special spring that can be used as a surgical implant for cancer patients. Mr. Abhinav Kumar spoke about Rural Utility Vehicle called EVOMO, that he designed and Mr. Shama Sundara discussed his innovative CSR programme.



The panel members shared their experiences and the subsequent discussions reinforced the understanding of the challenges in innovating. They noted that their innovations were driven by customers' needs and a belief that the problems can be solved. All of them said that passion was important to succeed at innovating and most of the challenges could be overcome if you persist.

#### **Workshop on Content Analysis**

Professor Srinath Jagannathan, Faculty, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, conducted a 5-day workshop on Content Analysis at IIM Indore during December 8-12, 2014.

The workshop, divided in 10 sessions, covered topics like Social or Economic Concerns, A 12-year content analysis of the Journal of Black Psychology, Longitudinal Content Analysis, Analyzing Mission Statements, Web Media and Content Analysis, Website evaluation of top 100 hotels, Quantitative Content Analysis of Rapid Growth Firms, Charting the language of leadership, amongst several others.

The workshop was attended by the faculty members and FPM participants of the Institute.





#### Dr. A S. Pillai Delivers Talk on India's Global Leadership

Dr. A. Sivathanu Pillai, Founder CEO and Managing Director of the Brah Mos Aerospace Private Limited, delivered a talk on *India*'s *Global Leadership* at IIM Indore on December 10, 2014.

Dr. Pillai shared the experience of his association with eminent scientists like Vikram Sarabhai and Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, and narrated his various encounters with them. Dr. Pillai connected the working style of the great scientists to management and explained to the students that humility is an unmistakable quality of a great leader.

Dr. Prathap C. Reddy, Founder Chairman and Dr. Anupam Sibal, Group Medical Director, Apollo Hospitals, visited IIM Indore and interacted with the students on October 8, 2014.

Dr. Prathap C. Reddy, in his inspiring and thought provoking address to the IIM Indore community, spoke about the future of health care industry and emphasized the need for IT expertise in order to make healthcare more competitive. To create a self-sustainable model in the country, Dr. Reddy emphasized on the need of payment based health insurance.







The session witnessed active participation from an enthused audience who asked questions ranging from availability of qualified doctors (super-specialty domain) to the reason behind the cost effectiveness of Apollo's high-end health care facilities.

#### Lecture by Ms. Debolina Dutta, Head, Human Resource, VF Corporation (India)

The IPM Entrepreneurship Cell of IIM Indore organised a guest lecture and interactive session with Ms. Debolina Dutta, Head, Human Resource, VF Corporation, at the Institute on November 3, 2014.

The interaction provided the students with an insight into the corporate lifestyle and the qualities that the recruiters seek for in prospective employees. Ms. Dutta talked about her journey up the corporate ladder and explained the importance of identifying one's strengths and weaknesses to be able to choose the correct field of work. She advised the students not to follow the herd mentality and prejudices about work profiles.

Mr. Sharma encouraged the students to fight their fears and accept the challenge of doing something new and innovative. Sharing his views on entrepreneurship, he said that it gives him immense satisfaction to find his work yielding good results and making a difference to the life of people. He motivated the students to always strive for better results instead of settling with the good ones.

#### Dr. S.P. Parashar, Former Director, IIM Indore


