IIM Indore Hosts U.S. Charge d’Affaires to India, Participant Interaction Held



IIM Indore was delighted to host the Chargé d’Affaires, Ambassador A. Elizabeth Jones of the U.S. Embassy India, on campus on Wednesday, 22 February, 2023. This prominent visit comprised a meeting with Ambassador Jones and her team with Prof. Himanshu Rai, Director, IIM Indore, and the Deans of the institute.

Attending this meeting virtually from Cairo, Egypt, Prof. Rai, Director, IIM Indore, welcomed Ambassador Jones and her team and shared the various initiatives undertaken by the institute. Prof. Rai highlighted IIM Indore’s efforts to identify and address significant national challenges, including income inequality, rural and urban issues, lack of mentorship for entrepreneurs, and environmental concerns. 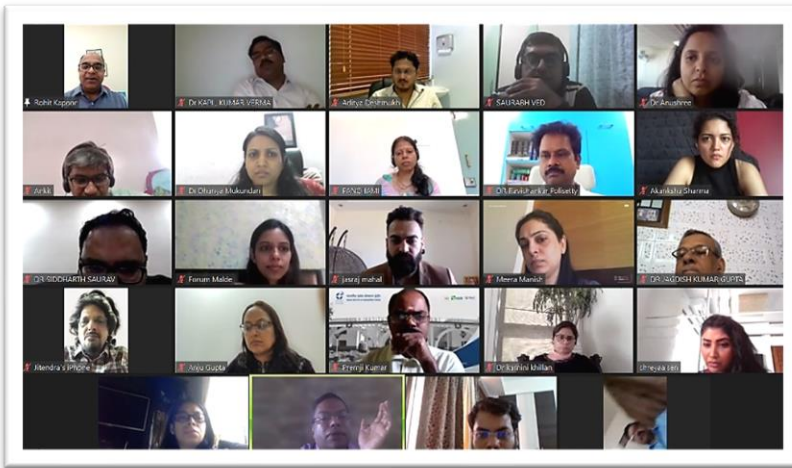

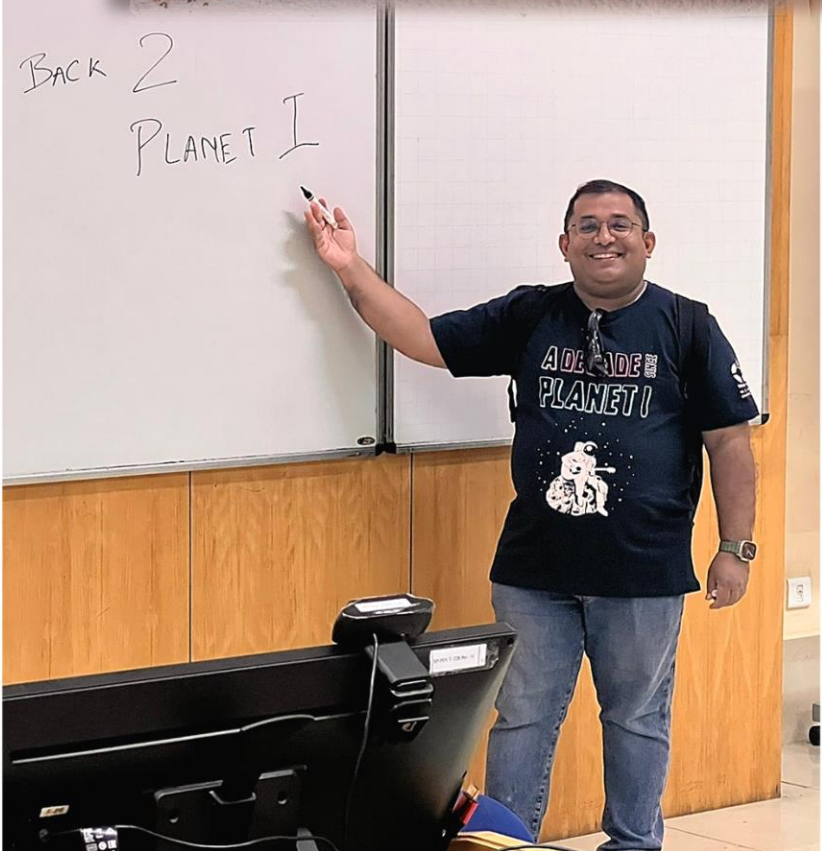

The day came to an end with a delicious dinner for the alumni, giving them a chance to further fraternise with their batchmates.

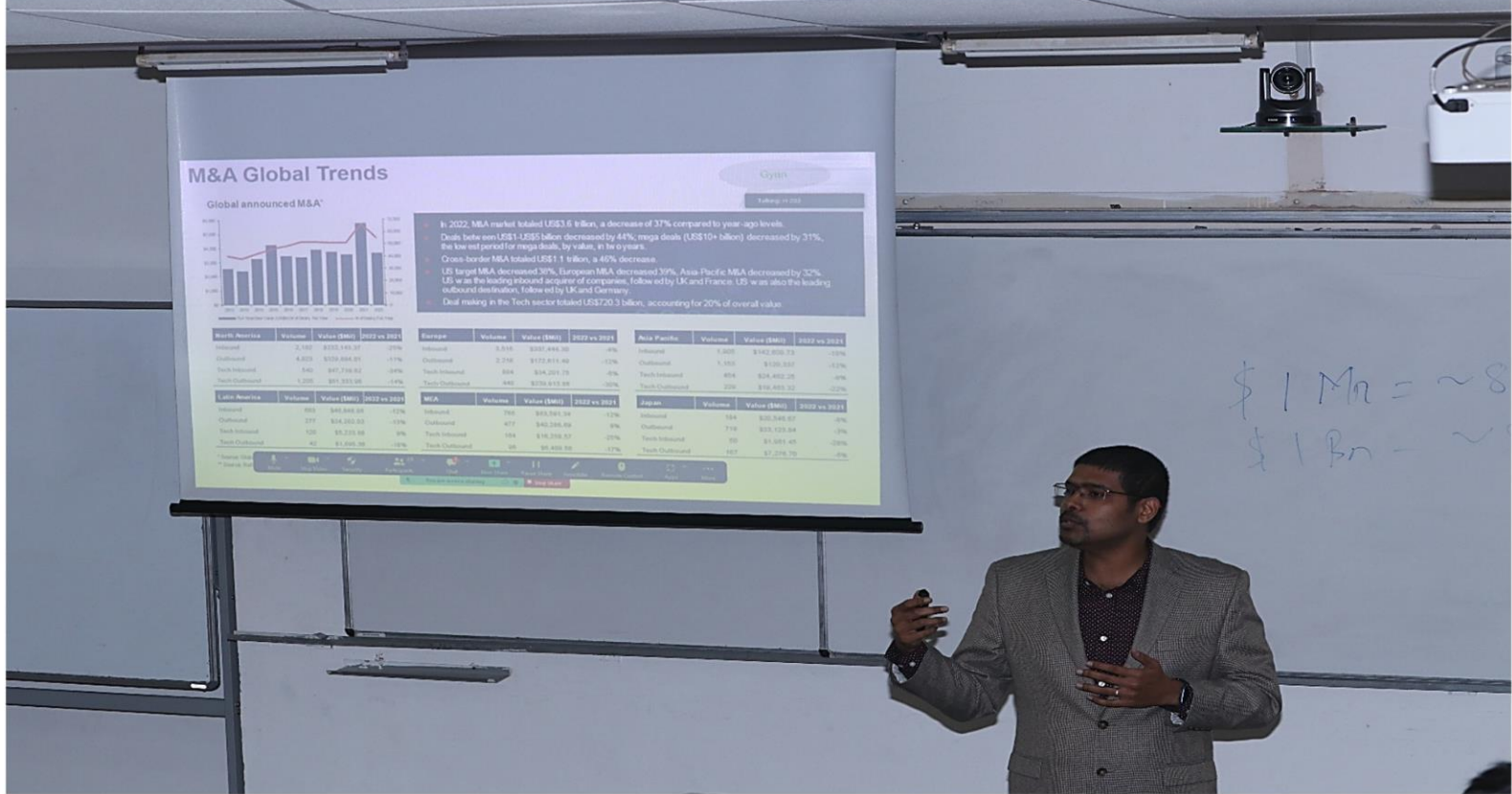

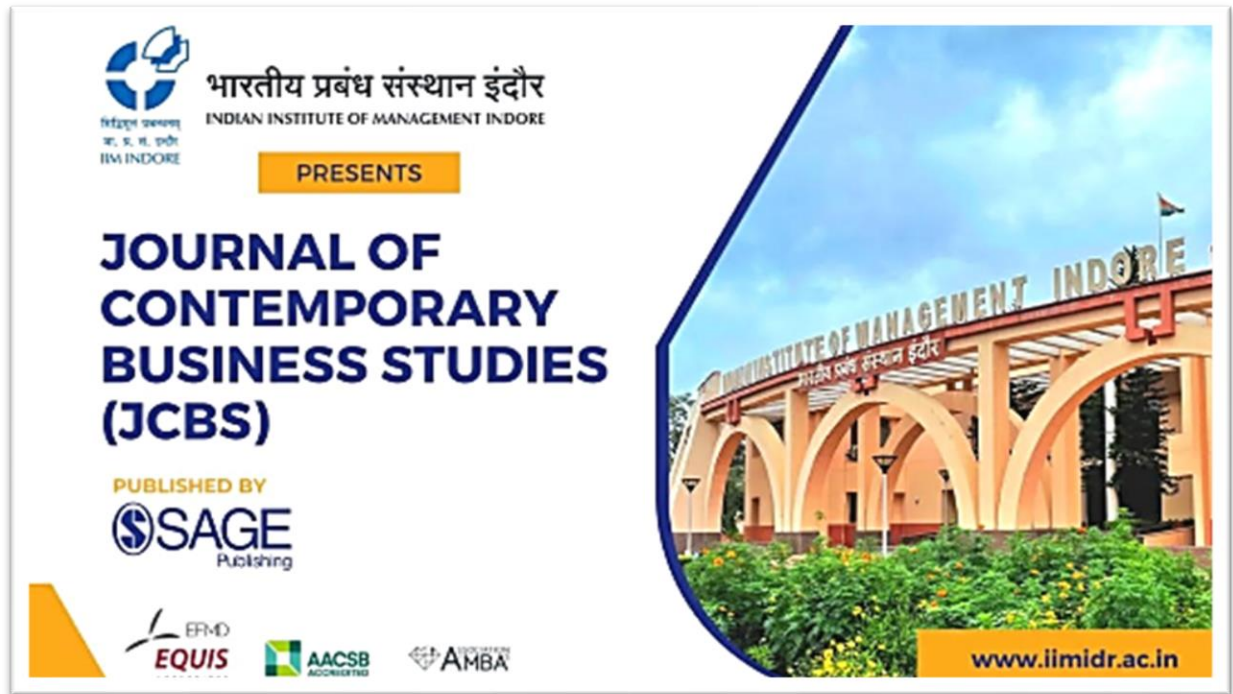

How did your entrepreneurial journey start?

My entrepreneurial journey started in 2010, as a student entrepreneur in the IIM Indore campus, when I started by first venture, Renewable Bazaar, which was a social network for renewable energy professionals, immediately after joining for the PGDM course. I won the NEN-IBM Student Entrepreneurs award in 2011 for this venture. Before the end of my course in 2012, I opted out of placement to chase my entrepreneurial dream, becoming the first participant from the campus to do so.

Briefly describe your business and why you chose this field?

After opting out of the final placements, I started my 2nd venture, Jeevanksh.com [Jeev Anksh Eco Products (P) Ltd.], in 2012 along with 4 of my batchmates from the campus [co-founder Rohit Bajaj, Alok Ekka, Jaitun Longa & Prashant Lakra]. The word Jeevanksh is an amalgamation of the Hindi words "Jeevan ka Ansh" that loosely translates to "ingredients of life". Under this venture, we are providing sustainably sourced, premium quality organic food products. To start this venture, we pulled in our scholarship money to start this as a B2C e-commerce venture, but pivoted to B2B business in 2015. This company is a decade old business now, and has been exporting organic food products of Northeast India to European Union & Southeast Asia. We won the 1st National Entrepreneurs Award by the MSDE (Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship), Govt. Of India in 2017, and receive the award by then Home Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh ji.

Meanwhile, I closed down my first venture, Renewable Bazaar in 2015, due to lack of traction & external fund.

In 2019, while interacting with smallholder organic farmers of Northeast, I realised that most of the farmers are not able to expand their cultivation due to lack of capital; thus limiting their growth. And smallholder farmers from across the country, echoed this same problem. I ideated on solving this problem with my fellow batchmate and friend, Alok Ekka, who has Banking and Fintech experience, and we formulated a plan to solve the financial problem of the farmers. Through this ideation, we (Alok & I), started an Agri-Fintech venture in 2020, named FarmInfinity.com [Farameasy Technologies (P) Ltd.]. We have created India's first credit-scoring and risk assessment model for smallholder farmers, and are facilitating easy access for financial services (credit & insurance) to these farmers, through our BFSI (Banking, Financial Services & Insurance) partners. In this venture, we have received a lot of interest from VCs (venture capital) as well as Agritech companies. Currently we are operating out of Assam, but are aggressively planning for expansion to the rest of India. We recently (on Feb. 20, 2022) received our 1st Patent for one of our solution, that is on the process of interaction between users (farmers/rural customers) and banks for credit disbursement and credit monitoring.

Social entrepreneurship came naturally to me; and the "Rural Immersion" program by IIM Indore, helped me solidify this passion to support rural India through entrepreneurship for their sustainable development. I choose to work with the smallholder farmers of India, as I realised, I can positively impact their lives, as India still has over 60% of their population in the rural area, dependent on Agriculture.

What were the major challenges you faced in starting your business?

Being a first generation entrepreneur and coming from a family with 2 generations in Govt. Jobs, it is always very difficult. During the initial days of my entrepreneurial journey, convincing my family and friends was a major hurdle. As I opted out of placement, I was considered a fool. The financial hardship is very difficult to explain. At one point in time (early 2014), after losing lot of money in the e-comm business, in Mumbai, I was living off with a single meal of a Vadapav (Rs. 10/-) for the whole day. But because of my stubbornness and single mindedness, I kept moving forward, and pivoted the business model of Jeevanksh from B2C to B2B, which has become successful now. After receiving the National Award from the Home Minister of India, my family got convinced that I can build a career as an Entrepreneur.

Working in the rural sector and convincing farmers to adopt organic agriculture is another hurdle that I faced. Farmers are reluctant to change their old ways of cultivation. I could achieve them by working with the farmer communities, on ground, for over 3 years, helping them in all of their problem, by becoming their friend.

Did you go for external funding for your start-up/ firm? What factors helped you to secure such funding?

Jeevanksh is a cash positive, bootstrapped business. We did receive grants and cash award through various startup schemes by Govt. Of India.

Yes, we have received external fund for our Agri-Fintech startup, FarmInfinity. We have raised Family & Friends (F&F) round of equity investment from a retd. IAS Officer, and have received grants from State Govt. of Assam & a PSU company. For the equity funding, it was more of a personal relationship and past record of successfully running a business that convinced the retd. IAS Officer to invest in our business. For the grants, we had to make multiple pitches to the decision making body of these grant approval organisations. As ours is a Tech company, we also received Cloud credits from our incubators IIM Calcutta Innovation Park (IIMC-IP), JioGenNext & from Financial Times.

I believe the major factor that helped us secure these fundings are our past record, as well as our growth as well as the market potential of the sector, along with the passion and team of our startup.

What would be your advice for an MBA who is considering a start-up?

I would like to give the same advice that I received from the then Director of IIM Indore, Dr. N. Ravichandran Sir, while informing him about my plan to opt out of placements and start my venture.

He said to me: "Follow your dreams, money will follow."

Now is the "Amrit-kaal" or Golden age to be an Entrepreneur in India. With over 65% of the population below the age of 35 years, anyone who sets out to start their entrepreneurial journey, has the potential to succeed.

Keep learning, keep growing.
