- Industry Outlook helps you anticipate trends in 207 industries. Expected creation of new capacities, projected financial performance, price movements of commodities, demand-supply balances or gaps in the future these are some of the indicators that Industry Outlook provides information on.
- Industry Outlook is particularly useful in understanding the current and expected trends in the economic environment that your industry operates in. These are your suppliers' industries, your customers' industries or your competing industries.

Excel Add-In

CMIE provides Excel add-in facility to download data from the CMIE website directly into your excel files.

To use this facility, you need to download an '.xlam' file and install it in MS Excel on your PC.

Once you have downloaded and installed the add-in, you are ready to download CMIE data directly into your Excel spread sheets.

Please 'click here' to understand how to download data into your Excel sheet using standard CMIE syntaxes.

Using the Add-in

There are two ways in which you can download CMIE data directly into your Excel sheet. One way is by using a function in a cell, just like the usual Excel functions of '=sum()' or '=average()'. The other way is by using fixed CMIE syntax in a few cells and using a hotkey.

For downloading data using the Excel Add-in, the numeric codes of indicators are used. English names of indicators cannot be used to download.

To obtain the codes of indicators, you need to go to the 'Indicators Search' tab on the menu bar and click on the "Full list of indicators" link. It will download a zip file. The zip file contains a .txt file which has the full list of indicators with their english names and their corresponding codes.

In case you are already viewing a tabulation of indicators, then on the left side of the page just below the menu bar you will see a link with the words 'Indicators in this report'. If you click on this link, it will show a list of the indicators in that tabulation with the indicator code in brackets just next to the indicator name. You can obtain the indicator code from this page too.

These indicator codes need to be used while using the Excel Add-in to download information.
