IPM

IIM Indore's Five-Year Integrated Programme in Management (henceforth IPM) is an innovative, unique and creative programme. The IPM of IIM Indore has been designed to meet the aspirations of young undergraduate students, (who have passed out class XII / Higher Secondary or equivalent from various schools in India), to become management professionals, change agents and societal leaders.

The programme is designed to provide intellectual maturity, a holistic education, and lay foundations of leadership qualities in the students so that they can craft a career of their own choice and make a difference to themselves and society.



PGP

The Post Graduate Programme (PGP) in Management at IIM Indore is a two-year, full-time, residential programme. The programme aims to groom participants into competent professional managers with

- a capacity to learn and adapt to national and international environment;
- an orientation towards achieving excellence, maintaining high ethical standards; and
- a capacity to work effectively and efficiently, both individually and in groups.

The Post Graduate Programme in Management is spread over two years, each year consisting of three terms. While transiting from the first to the second year, the participant spends eight weeks on a summer project in an organization.

EPPG

The EPPG is structured to prepare executives for transformational leadership positions. During the intense one-year programme, they will work towards developing a deeper understanding of various facets of management and hone their managerial skills. The programme is spread over five academic terms in IIM Indore campus and one International Immersion module at one of the top-ranking international universities.

The first three terms (mostly composed of core courses) focus on laying the foundation for the specialisation through a bundle of electives offered in the other terms. An international module provides an opportunity to develop an understanding of the global business environment and an ability to operate in a multicultural environment. The last two terms are mostly electives and other experiential learning.

PGPHRM

The Post Graduate Programme in Human Resource Management (PGP-HRM) at IIM Indore is a two-year, full-time, residential programme. The programme commenced from the academic year 2018. The programme aims to groom participants into professional managers with a capacity:

- to integrate human resource and business issues emerging in a dynamic environment;
- to apply an understanding of behavioural tenets for harnessing value in organizations and society;
- to apply an analytical orientation in creating sustainable and innovative value creation frameworks.

The Post Graduate Programme in Human Resource Management is spread over two years, each year consisting of three terms. While transiting from the first to the second year, the participant spends eight weeks on a summer project in an organization. The academic year begins in June/July and ends in March/April of the following year.

PGPMX

The IIM Indore two-year, alternate weekend Post Graduate Programme in Management for Working Executives PGPMX, offered in Mumbai, is uniquely designed for working executives and entrepreneurs, who would like to take the opportunity to become transformational leaders and innovative solution creators in their respective organizations, but find it difficult to pursue a full-time programme in management. PGPMX is designed to provide flexibility to working executives to be engaged in their respective professions and at the same time to upgrade their knowledge. Successful completion of the Programme would lead to the award of Master of Business Administration degree.

DPM

The Doctoral Programme at IIMI is a unique doctoral programme in management. It is designed to provide both breadth and depth of knowledge to doctoral participants in management. The programme has two-fold objective of enabling the participants to master the relevant methodological tools of management research on one hand, and the advancement of the current body of management knowledge on the other. The DPM track offers prospects of a career within academia or in (research) positions outside the academia world. Programme's rigorous curriculum provides ample training for an academic career and gives participants the opportunity to make an indelible mark on the research activity in their respective field. The programme offers specialization in various areas of management.

With the rapid expansion of management education in India, it has become inevitable that top business schools cater to the need of the faculty by producing excellent researchers and academicians. The Doctoral programme in Management at IIMI is aimed to contribute to this societal need. All DPM students are fully funded during the course of their study upto four years.

EDPM

Executive Doctoral Programme in Management (formerly Fellow Programme in Management (Industry)) is a unique doctoral level programme in management for working professionals that culminates in a PhD in Management. The programme had a long legacy, started in the year 2011 it is amongst the first such programmes for working professionals offered by an IIM. Till date 39 professionals have graduated from the programme and there are about 90 candidates across different batches currently enrolled in the programme. The Executive DPM Programme has evolved over the years and it currently offers a PhD degree. The programme offers a rigorous coursework and opportunity to pursue research in the guidance of some of the best researchers in the management domain.

EDPMG

The Executive Doctoral Programme in Management and Governance (EDPMG) is a unique doctoral programme for working Senior Officers in the Indian Administrative Services and Indian Armed Forces. Initiated in 2021, the program is one of the first such programs for officers offered by an IIM, which culminates with a PhD degree in management. The programme offers rigorous course work and the opportunity to pursue research in the guidance of some of the best management researchers. IIM Indore currently has one of the biggest cohorts of doctoral candidates (more than 162 across both its doctoral programmes) in the management domain in the country. The programme is expected to enable IIM Indore to contribute to effective governance of the country and nation-building. Also, it will leverage the experience and capability of the country's civil servants, army officers and public managers', while building their capability, and making them research inclined.





Information on International Exchange Programmes

At IIM Indore, we believe that it is important for aspiring business students to gain both international exposure and international perspective. Studying in a foreign country is definitely an experience of a lifetime and every student should get an opportunity to try it out at least once during his or her academic career. It is exactly with this belief that this student Exchange Programme has been Instituted.

A highly internationalized approach applied business knowledge, and a strong network of partners are the cornerstones of IIM Indore educational model and the basis for all the programs offered with a bachelor's & Master's program.

IIM Indore provides an enriching academic experience to incoming students and at the same time its student community also benefits from the fresh trains of thought and new ideas that the foreign students have to offer. This mutual learning experience is what we aim to give students.

IIM Indore has established strong relationships with several Universities and Business Schools over the world and the list continues to grow. Participating in the exchange programme requires a student of IIM Indore to undertake full-time study for one or two semesters at any of its international partner institutes.



Post Graduate Programme in Human Resource Management (The Graduate Exchange Programme)

HRM Programme will enable participants to understand the business rationalities that drive human behavior in organizations. They will be empowered to draw upon psychometric instruments and applied psychological tools in shaping human relations with organizations. Participants will be introduced to techniques through which they can deploy an analytic orientation in understanding human behavior in organizations and shaping evidence-based Interventions. They will build practical skills with respect to various HRM functions. The programme aims to groom participants into professional managers with a capacity.

- to integrate human resources and businesses in a dynamic environment.
- to apply an understanding of behavioral tenets for harnessing value in organizations
- to apply an analytical orientation in creating sustainable and innovative value creation frameworks.

Post Graduate Programme in Management (The Graduate Exchange Programme)

The Post Graduate Programme (PGP) in IIM Indore is a two- year, full-time, residential MBA Program. With the enactment of "The Indian Institutes of Management Act 2017," On 31st January 2018, the Institute was empowered with the legal authority to award degrees. It's programme recognized by the Association of Indian Universities and is considered equivalent to the MBA Degree in April 2001. The programme aims to groom participants into competent professional managers with:

- a capacity to learn and adapt to an international environment.
- an orientation towards achieving excellence, maintaining high ethical standards and
- a capacity to work effectively and efficiently, both individually and in groups.

The Five-Year Integrated Programme in Management (The Undergraduate Exchange Programme)

Launched by IIM Indore in 2011, the five-year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) is the first of its kind in India. The programme has been accredited by the Association of MBA London (4th and 5th Year). It is a unique and creative programme meant for young students with managerial and leadership aspirations. Through the IPM, IIM Indore seeks to attract young students and mould them as outstanding leaders through a world class education.

The undergraduate course has three major elements:

- Courses in Mathematics Statistics and Economics build analytical rigor.
- Courses in Psychology, sociology, and political science along with the courses in Economics provide an understanding of the core disciplines on which the study of management is based.
- Courses in Humanities Literature and Fine Arts provide breadth and perspective.

Unique programme offered under flagship programme (The Graduate Exchange Programme)

The Himalayan Outbound Programme

Management is not only taught in closed classrooms but is also learnt through experience and reflection, and every second-year student of the PGP programme gets a chance to explore this in the lap of the Himalayas.

The students go through multiple rounds of training, focusing on adventure sports and real-life challenges, designed to test their managerial and leadership skills. From rock climbing, rappelling and river rafting, to yoga and pranayama, the Himalayan Outbound Programme offers a mix of physical and psychological experiential tasks for the students.

To elucidate, the range of activities include Last Year's Batch which went to Kedarkantha basic survival training - cooking competitions, firewood collection, setting up the tent, and various mountain tasks where teams strategize and perform together, which tests their leadership skills and team dynamics. The second leg of training entails engaging the students in social work by helping villages close to the base camps by providing an innovative solution to their basic problems through the application of their classroom learning.



Rural Engagement Programme

Rural Engagement Programme (REP) is a unique initiative that was instituted with an objective to sensitize the budding managers and entrepreneurs of this Institute towards the various schemes undertaken by the government in villages and to study and analyze their execution and effectiveness. Spread over a week, across several districts in Madhya Pradesh, the programme's main objective is to be an eye opener as it provides insights on the various dimensions of district level administration, focusing primarily on the policy administration and the execution gaps associated with the rural population at large.

Facilities Available at IIM Indore



Classrooms: The classrooms at IIM Indore create an atmosphere that is conducive to learning and nurtures the quest for knowledge that the students possess. The lecture theaters/classrooms offer a linear seating arrangement whereas the MDP classrooms provide more flexibility with round tables which can be arranged in an ad-hoc fashion to facilitate more interaction among the participants. All classrooms are air-conditioned and equipped with all modern teaching aids.



Auditorium: The Institute also has two auditoriums, each having an amphitheater. The Auditorium-1 (old auditorium) has 300-seating capacity while Auditorium-2 (new auditorium) has 800-seating capacity, which is situated at the Sports Complex. The auditoriums are well furnished, fully air-conditioned and with state of the art audio, video facilities and seating capacity of 300 students is available for the conduct of various functions to facilitate student's activities. Students aptly utilize the auditorium facilities.



IIM Indore Learning Center: The IIM Indore Learning Centre (LC) with its modern collection of knowledge resources and innovative information services, fills an essential role for students, faculty, and the surrounding community in their intellectual pursuits. Mess Facilities: Dedicated mess facilities and round-the-clock canteen facilities with vegetarian and non-vegetarian food are also available to the students. Various other snacks, biscuits, chocolates, ice cream and soft drinks are available in the mess itself. The students also run a self-managed goods store - PI Shop that stocks anything from stationery and snacks to self-care products and daily need items.



State Bank of India E-Corner: Apart from a Bank and two ATMs at the Campus, IIM Indore also has State Bank of India (SBI) E-Corner with all advanced banking facilities like Internet Kiosk Banking Cash Deposit Machine, ATM and SWYAM (the machine for printing passbook at one's convenience).



Hostel Block Facilities: Each hostel block has a common room where facilities such as wall-mounted televisions with DTH connection, table tennis tables, dart game and carrom and chess games are available. It is the common room that provides the scene of action for get-togethers, parties and informal discussions. Each block is also equipped with water coolers and water purifiers.

- Community Center

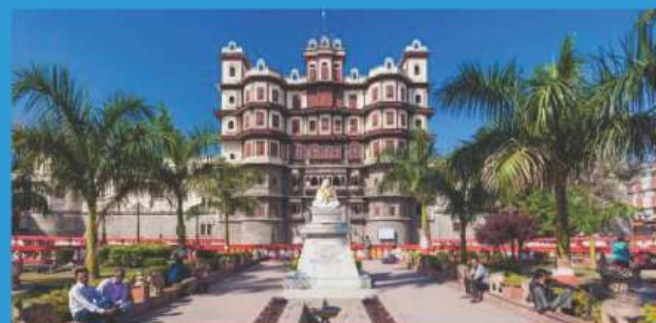
