Market Reactions to Indian General Elections: An Event Study of Central Public Sector Enterprises *Mulund College of Commerce (June 2024- August 2024)*

This thesis explores the volatility in various Indian stock market's sectoral indices over the period of 7 years, from January 2018 to January of 2025. A comparative analysis of ARCH and GARCH models indicates that GARCH (1,1) provides a better fit for sectors with prolonged volatility shocks, such as metals and oil & gas, whereas ARCH models capture short-term fluctuations in sectors like consumer durables and pharma. Furthermore, external factors such as crude oil price movements significantly impact NIFTY OIL & GAS, while regulatory changes drive volatility in NIFTY PHARMA.

Market Reactions to Indian General Elections: An Event Study of Central Public Sector Enterprises *Mulund College of Commerce (June 2024- August 2024)*

Conducted a comprehensive event study to analyse the impact of the 2024 Lok Sabha elections on the stock performance of 11 major Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) in sectors like energy, defence, and infrastructure. Focused on understanding how political transitions influence investor behaviour and financial performance. The study highlighted the sensitivity of CPSEs to government policy changes, providing insights relevant to emerging markets.
