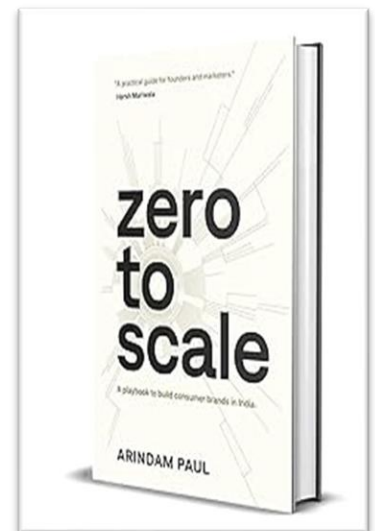

We are here to walk alongside each student, nurturing them with care, courage, and compassion.

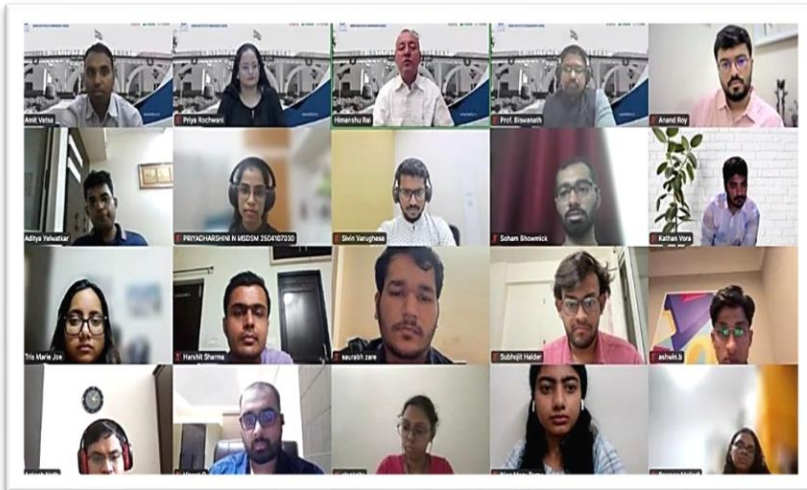
New Batch | Day 2 kicked off bright and early as the youngest batch at IIM Indore hit the ground running - literally!

Research Seminar | Why does a gender gap persist in cryptocurrency adoption and participation?

8 Aug 2025: What does it reveal about the evolving digital economy?

To explore these questions, IIM Indore was pleased to host Prof. Akansha Jalan, Associate Professor in the Finance & Accounting area at Rennes School of Business, France, for a research talk under the IIM Indore Seminar Series.

Her talk, titled "The Cryptocurrency Gender Gap," delved into the intersection of finance, technology, and gender, offering insightful perspectives on the structural and behavioral barriers shaping this divide.

The session was coordinated by Prof. Sujay Mukhoti, Faculty in the Operations Management & Quantitative Techniques area at IIM Indore.

Through such seminars, IIM Indore reaffirms its commitment to encouraging meaningful academic dialogue and global knowledge exchange.



Research Seminar | How can firms design strategies for product reusability in the face of uncertain supply chains?

9 Aug 2025: To explore this timely question, IIM Indore had the pleasure of hosting Prof. Prashant Chintapalli, Assistant Professor in the Management Science Area at Ivey Business School, Western University (UWO), Canada, for a research talk under the IIM Indore Seminar Series.



His talk, titled “Managing Product-Reusability Under Supply Disruptions,” offered valuable insights into resilient and sustainable operations management.

The session was coordinated by Prof. Sujay Kumar Mukhoti, Faculty in the Operations Management & Quantitative Techniques area at IIM Indore. At IIM Indore, we remain committed to promoting global research dialogue and encouraging impactful knowledge exchange.

Industry Conclave | How are global markets, evolving risk practices, and AI transforming the future of banking and finance?

23 Aug 2025: To explore these questions, IIM Indore’s Industry Interface Office (IIO), organized the Industry Conclave on “Banking and Finance” on August 23, 2025. The event was inaugurated by our Director, Prof. Himanshu Rai. He reminded the audience that India’s financial rise must be inclusive. Beyond booming markets and digital revolutions, he stressed that true progress rests on hard work, resilience, and a “never say never” spirit to build Viksit Bharat.



The conclave featured thought-provoking sessions by distinguished speakers. Mr. Akshay Agrawal, Director – Global Capital Markets (IB Origination & Advisory) at Deutsche India Pvt. Ltd., discussed the evolving landscape of offshore bond issuance from India. Mr. Vikram Duggal, Risk Consultant at a UAE-based Fintech and IIM Indore alumnus (EPGP 2009-10), spoke on the evolution of credit risk management—from gut instincts to Gen AI.

Mr. Shrikant Kejriwal, SVP II and Head – AI & Analytics at Axis Bank, and IIM Indore alumnus (EPGP 2011-12), reflected on the challenges and opportunities in Indian banking, with a focus on MSMEs and AI-powered lending.

The event concluded with an engaging panel discussion moderated by Prof. Mitul Surana, followed by a lively Q&A session that made the conclave truly interactive and insightful. Prof. Punyashlok Dwibedy, Chair - IIO, delivered the vote of thanks. At IIM Indore, we remain dedicated to bridging industry and academia, nurturing future leaders, and driving conversations that shape the future of business and society.

At IIM Indore, we don't just teach growth, we co-create it.

Today's Round Table on "Doubling Indore's GDP by 2030", inaugurated by our Director, Prof. Himanshu Rai, became a high-octane brainstorming lab where ideas leapt from whiteboards to workable roadmaps.

30 Aug 2025: Prof. Rai set the tone, linking India's momentum, 7.8% GDP growth (Q1 FY25-26) and 1,947 crore UPI transactions worth ₹25.1 lakh crore (July '25), to Indore's runway. He mentioned that Indore can double its economy (~₹65,000 crore in 2020-21) in five years by pushing pharma & medical devices (bulk-drug park, device hub, 10,000 jobs), IT & services, and textiles & apparel (₹10,000 crore output; ₹3,000 crore exports), while lifting women's participation to 35%.



Mr. Shankar Lalwani (MP, Indore) called 2047 a near-term sprint, urging a strategy-first approach across education, healthcare, public amenities, clean mobility, and logistics to make Indore a national hub.

Prof. Ganesh Kumar drew Singapore-style lessons: clean governance, infrastructure, and skills. Prof. Punyashlok Dwibedy, Chair, Industry Interface Office, emphasized policy stability, sharper IT-park execution, and industry-academia alliances to crowd in investment.

Outcome? A shared, actionable playbook, full of innovation, inclusion, and infrastructure, to make Indore a benchmark for sustainable, opportunity-rich growth!

As we move towards India@2047, IIM Indore will continue to stand at the forefront, shaping a future that is inclusive, sustainable, and filled with possibility.

IIMI Impact | IIM Indore continues to champion meaningful dialogue, leadership, and women empowerment through purposeful engagements.

6 Aug 2025: It was a delight hosting 43 accomplished businesswomen from the Indore Management Association (IMA) Women's Forum, in a day filled with purpose, dialogue, and inspiration.
