The social internship is a 6-8 week opportunity for participants of IIM Indore's flagship five-year Integrated Programme in Management to contribute to, and gain from multi-disciplinary roles in organisations such as Policy Research Institutions, Non-Profit Organisations, Startup Incubators, Impact-Investing firms, and Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) wings of companies. Solving real-world social problems at the social internships gives IPM students with a unique perspective of the ground realities and helps them grow into mature decision makers.

Corporate Social Responsibility

CSR emerged as the most preferred vertical for social internships, with ~41% of the batch opting for roles from the CSR wings of leading corporations including Ambuja Cement, Bharti Airtel, DLF, Dr. Reddy's, Ernst and Young, HCL, Indian Oil, JM Financial, Larsen & Toubro, NTPC, ONGC, Oppo India, SAIL, Tech Mahindra and Vodafone Idea.

Social Incubators and Impact Investors

Nearly 14% of the students were selected in roles involving expanding social causes through incubation and investment in brands like Capconnect Asia, The/Nudge Institute, Anveshan Center for Excellence (IIM Indore), NSRCEL (IIM Bangalore).

Research Institutes and Think Tanks

Around 20% of the batch opted for research roles in esteemed social and policy research enterprises like the Impact Investors Council, Institute of Chinese Studies, HTIC (IIT Madras), Ola Mobility Institute and Chintan Environmental Research & Action Group.

Non-Profit Organizations

Over 8% of the students interned at prominent NGOs and NPOs from across the country. Some of these prominent non-profits are Citizen News Service, Paani Foundation, Take Action Global and Vimove Foundation.

Government Organizations

About 17% of the students secured roles with key government bodies working on national-level social and policy initiatives. Student Activities

The IPM Community at IIM Indore indulges itself wholeheartedly, not only in academics but various extra-curricular activities ranging from inter-batch competitions to organizing national level festivals. The IPM students have diversified skills by being an active part of clubs, committees, and various special interest groups.

The 'Student Activity Council' or IPM SAC is nominated by the students and serves as a body of individuals that aids the development of skills and leadership qualities in the students. The council's mandate spans developing intrinsic entrepreneurial capabilities, managing infrastructural facilities, and conducting cultural events to promote a welcoming and inclusive campus atmosphere.

Some of the entities within the IPM SAC that provide students with opportunities to develop managerial and organizational skills include:

IPM Academic Committee: The IPM Academic Committee acts as the bridge between the 450+ students of the IPM programme and the administration of the institute. It strives to address all academic concerns of the students and presents them further before the IPM Executive Council to aid their resolution. It also provides valuable recommendations regarding daily academic activities and healthy scheduling of the curriculum while keeping the students aware of the upcoming academic events, rules and policies of the institute.

IPM Cultural Club: The IPM Cultural Club of IIM Indore envisions filling colours in the lives of students. It creates opportunities so that they can take a break from all the academic and work engagements to unwind and have something to look forward to. The Cultural Committee emphasises community-building activities for the students and works to bring them closer - across batches - by celebrating festivals like Diwali, Christmas, and Thanksgiving together. Hosting inter-college events like IIT VS IIM is one of the numerous other events conducted by the Cultural Club. Through these initiatives, the club fosters a strong sense of togetherness and ensures students feel at home within the campus environment.

IPM Infrastructure Committee: The IPM Infrastructure Committee aims to maintain a safe, conducive, and convenient environment for the 450+IPM participants on the IIM Indore campus. One of the primary responsibilities of this committee is overseeing the welfare and living conditions of students residing in the hostels. Furthermore, the committee's responsibilities extend to supervising the provision of food, transportation services, and maintaining the infrastructure across the 193-acre IIM Indore campus. Acting as student representatives, the committee maintains open lines of communication with campus authorities, advocating for student concerns and addressing issues promptly.

IPM Media, PR, and Outreach Committee: The IPM Media, PR & Outreach Committee at IIM Indore is pivotal in representing and enhancing the IPM programme's brand image. Through platforms such as Linkedln, YouTube, Instagram, and Quora, they broaden the programme's reach to a diverse audience, including high school students and industry recruiters. The committee conducts outreach initiatives (where IPM students visit schools to promote awareness about the programme) and events like the IPM LitFest (which supports social causes and fosters community spirit). Additionally, they host activities such as Fresher's Week, Oracle, and Chiraag to strengthen bonds within the IPM community, ensuring a cohesive and vibrant campus life.

IPM Sports Committee: The IPM Sports Committee aims to enhance the interest of the participants in the field of sports. The committee organises 50+ sports competitions throughout the year, to foster the spirit of sportsmanship, which comes along with virtues like hard work, cooperation, strategy-making and good communication among the participants of the IPM Programme. The IPM Sports Committee is also responsible for the training and development of sports persons and providing them with a platform to take part in competitions all over the country.

IPM Literary, Cultural, Management and Sports Fest

Atharv Ranbhoomi, exclusively organized by IPM students at IIM Indore, is renowned as the largest college festival in Central India. With a remarkable footfall exceeding 90,000 and a digital footprint reaching 28 million, this event provides students with unparalleled hands-on experience. It equips them with the skills necessary to thrive in their careers and beyond, transforming them into polished, well-rounded individuals capable of delivering consistently under pressure. Our students undertake extensive responsibilities during Atharv Ranbhoomi, including:

Financial Management: Preparing and monitoring the budget, financial policies, revenues, and expenses, managing a turnover exceeding 80 lakhs INR.

Sponsorship and Partnerships: Negotiating with 15+ government and corporate agencies such as UP Tourism, Sparx, TooYum etc to secure sponsorship deals worth over 25 lakhs, and collaborating with 15+ major food brands, including Starbucks and Baskin Robbins, to generate a revenue of 5+ lakhs.

Accommodation, Logistics and Operations: Negotiating and securing deals exceeding 10 lakhs to address logistical requirements and ensure the operational functionality of the fest. Managing accommodation and transportation arrangements for over 1500 participants, with deals totalling more than 20 lakhs.

Artist Coordination and Negotiation: Successfully securing and managing at least four artist deals each year, with a total value exceeding 40 lakhs. This includes renowned performers such as King, Raftaar, Neeti Mohan, Aditya Kulshreshth, Nishant Suri, and others.

Event Management: Organizing and managing 45+ independent events across cultural, sports, management, and literary domains with a prize pool of over 15 lakhs.

Media and Digital Presence: Collaborating with over 100 media partners to engage a digital audience exceeding 10 million. Crafting an informative and dynamic website to ensure a seamless user experience and optimize SEO for maximum reach.

Participant Engagement and Coordination: Communicating and bringing participation of over 20,000 students from more than 300 colleges nationwide.

Marketing and Outreach: Implementing comprehensive social media marketing strategies by producing over 100 high-quality designs and videos for the fest's social media platforms, achieving an organic reach of more than 1 million. Organizing pre-fest events, including seminars, corporate leagues, workshops, street plays, and flash mobs, to amplify the fest's presence and engagement within Indore city.

Merchandising & Sales: Designing and selling fest merchandise, generating over 3 lakhs in revenue. Additionally, selling passes to attendees, contributing an additional 2+ lakhs in revenue.

Documentation and Coordination: Designing banking, sponsorship, and event brochures to ensure professionalism and information accuracy. Serving as a liaison between 13 fest verticals, authorities, and external vendors to facilitate seamless communication and coordination among all stakeholders.

Industry Interaction and Entrepreneurial Culture

The IPM Entrepreneurship and Industry Connect Cell (E-Cell) at IIM Indore fosters entrepreneurial talent and business acumen within the IPM community. They provide resources, mentorship, and opportunities for collaboration with professors, alumni, and industry professionals, helping students turn their ideas into successful ventures while promoting a culture of innovation and continuous learning.

The Entrepreneurship Cell also runs IIM Indore's first seed funding competition, Escalon, with a prize pool of over 2 lakh INR.

The E-Cell has facilitated student internships in companies across the country and the globe, in companies such as TATA Steel, HCL, EY, and more.

Live projects acquaint students with the vision of the working environment and reinforce leadership qualities and discipline at work. We have associated with Tata International, Radisson Blu, Sayaji hotels, AiCTSL, Shakti pumps, Arucom Electronics and many more, and conducted visits to BSE, Indian Oil Corporation, SEBI, Cipla, RBI, and HUL to name a few.













Social Sensitivity

With Social Internships at the forefront, IIM Indore takes great pride in inculcating a sense of social responsibility in its students while providing world-class education. This is done through an active part students take in various student bodies which aim to bring about positive change in the society.

'Aasha': the IPM Social Club of IIM Indore is committed to bringing about societal change that positively affects all community members, including students, staff, faculty and people outside the campus. Its dedication to a sustainable future is reflected in its initiatives focused on environmental protection and social welfare. Furthermore, it believes in giving back to the community. Aasha facilitates opportunities for IPM students to volunteer and participate in various social drives to ensure the upward mobility of the underprivileged classes. It maintains a social media presence, highlighting its initiatives and meaningful contributions to society and the IPM community.

It also runs the 'El Amigo' peer counselling initiative, an initiative by the institute for helping students manage their psychological difficulties and social relations.

'i-Help': The IPM Social Literacy Organization is a student-driven voluntary teaching programme helping provide quality education to underprivileged children. By associating with various schools and NGOs, i-Help has impacted over 1,350 students in 4+ schools, delivering 3,600+ man hours and 3,000+ teaching hours with the support of 300+ volunteers.

Since its inception, i-Help has prepared students for prestigious scholarships like NMMS and JNVST, with 22 students securing scholarships worth over 10.56 lakh rupees in six years. Engaging students in co-curricular activities and life skills sessions, i-Help ensures holistic development, making education a cornerstone of societal growth and transformation.

Social Impact and Community Engagement in Atharv Ranbhoomi: The fest conducts a scholarship test for over 150 underprivileged children, with a prize pool of 40,000 rupees. Additionally, we coordinate and execute the Pi quiz competition, involving over 3,000 students from more than 500 schools nationwide, to help craft responsible leaders tomorrow.

I also analyzed entrepreneur demographics to refine cohort selection, produced a podcast on founder readiness and scaling, and facilitated patient capital discussions with Indian family offices.
