

Five-Year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) Admission Procedure for IPM 2026-31 Batch (International Applicants Applying through SAT)

Definition of International Applicants

Foreign passport holders only will be considered as ‘International Applicants’ for admission to the Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) of IIM Indore in 2026-31 batch.

Eligibility Criteria

International applicants (as defined above) satisfying the following criteria are eligible to apply for the Five-Year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) of IIM Indore.

- Age:** Candidate should have been born on or after August 01, 2006.
- Qualifying Exam:** Candidate should have passed Standard XII/HSC or equivalent examination in 2024, 2025 or appearing in 2026.
- Standard X/SSC or Equivalent:** Candidate should have passed standard X/ SSC.
- Valid SAT Score:** Minimum score of 1300 out of 1600 on SAT (SAT score obtained during November 1, 2024, to May 15, 2026, will only be considered as a valid score)

Note 1: Candidates who are likely to complete standard XII/ HSC or equivalent by the end of July 31, 2026, can also apply, subject to meeting the eligibility criteria mentioned above. If selected, such candidates will be offered provisional admission to the programme. At the time of registration for the programme, such candidates must produce standard X/ SSC and standard XII/ HSC or equivalent examination mark sheets, along with a school-leaving certificate/migration certificate, failing which the candidate’s provisional admission offer will stand cancelled.

Note 2: The percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in X and XII Standards would be calculated based on the aggregate marks of all subjects that appear in the mark sheet/gradesheet, irrespective of the Board’s regulation. In case the candidates are awarded letter grades or grade points instead of marks, the conversion of grades to a percentage of marks would be based on the procedure certified by the Board/ Competent Authority, explaining the method of conversion from where they have obtained the certificate.

Note 3: Applicants who completed their X and/or XII standard / pursuing their XII standard from international schools affiliated to foreign board’s like IGCSE (International General Certificate for Secondary Education) and IB (International Baccalaureate) (participants of IBDP and IBCP only), can also apply, and such candidates are required to produce “[The IB Indian Percentage Transcript](#)”.

Note 4: IIM Indore reserves the right to decide the eligibility conditions in terms of equivalence, percentage marks, and the recognition of the qualifying examination, intake, etc.

1. Application Procedure

An international applicant seeking admission to the Five-Year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) at IIM Indore can take the SAT in the country of their residence and apply for admission using the prescribed application form, available for download from our website.

The last date for receipt of a complete application is **May 20, 2026**. For such applicants, the application must include the following set of materials:

- a) Completed Application Form [[Online Form](#)].
- b) Self-Attested copy of the latest SAT scores (Original to be verified at the time of admission, if selected).
- c) Self-attested photocopies of standard X/ SSC and standard XII/ HSC or equivalent examinations.
- d) Self-Attested photocopy of Passport (all pages).
- e) A non-refundable/non-transferable application-processing fee of Rs. 8,850/- inclusive of GST through online bank transfer (Bank Account details are given on page number 3).

2. Selection Procedure

The candidates will be selected based on their performance in the SAT and Personal Interview (PI). The selection process is as follows:

Stage 1: The candidates who satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria should submit their applications as described previously under serial number 1, i.e., Application procedure.

Stage 2: An appropriate number of candidates (as per the decision of the Admissions Committee) for Personal Interview (PI) will be shortlisted using the merit list generated based on SAT Score. Individual regret letters will not be sent to applicants who are not shortlisted for a Personal Interview. IIM Indore also expects consistent, minimum performance across the different parameters of the Personal Interview (PI), which will be decided by the Admissions Committee. Candidates who do not meet the minimum performance level in any parameter will not be considered for the next stage of the selection process, i.e., Stage-3.

Stage 3: Only those candidates satisfying the requirements mentioned in earlier stages will be considered for final selection. The merit list will be generated based on the Composite Score (CS) as mentioned in Table-1, and provisional admission offers will be made accordingly, adhering to the approved intake norms for international applicants.

Table-1: Computation of Composite Score (CS)

Component	Score (Weight)
SAT Test Score *	65
Personal Interview (PI)	35
Composite Score (CS)	Sum of above scores

(* SAT Test Score = Candidate's overall SAT Test Score / Maximum possible SAT Test Score)

No intimation will be sent to candidates who are not selected for the final offer.

Note:

- IIM Indore has earmarked a total of 5 Seats for the International/ Foreign applicants under the provision of the Supernumerary Quota (this will be separate from the regular intake of the IPM programme).
- If an international applicant is selected for admission to the Programme, it will be the sole responsibility of the applicant to obtain and submit all the requisite clearance certificates from the Government of India, such as "No Objection Certificate" from the Ministry of Education, Government of India, etc. (as applicable) at the time of joining the Programme.
- The Indian Institutes of Management Act 2017 came into force from January 31, 2018 and accordingly students who will be enrolled in the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Indore's Five-Year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) for 2026-31 Batch will be eligible for award of Bachelor of Arts (Foundations of Management) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) degrees under Dual Degree Programme upon successful completion of IPM.
- IPM students who successfully completed the IPM programme in 2025 were conferred the above Degrees at the 26th Convocation of the Institute held on March 29, 2025.
- Candidates attempting to apply with minor changes of information and/or facts to more than one and/or multiple applications will be summarily rejected, and such candidates will be debarred from further selection process.
