Rankings | IIM Indore continues to hold the top position among all IIMs in the UI Green Metric Rankings 2025.





His talk, titled “Temporal Framing of Price Promotions: Effects on Consumer Perceptions of Deal Transience and Consumption Judgments,” offered valuable insights into how promotional timing shapes consumer psychology and decision-making.

Mr. Pravesh Vaishnav enriched the occasion with reflections that bridged ancient wisdom and modern relevance.


