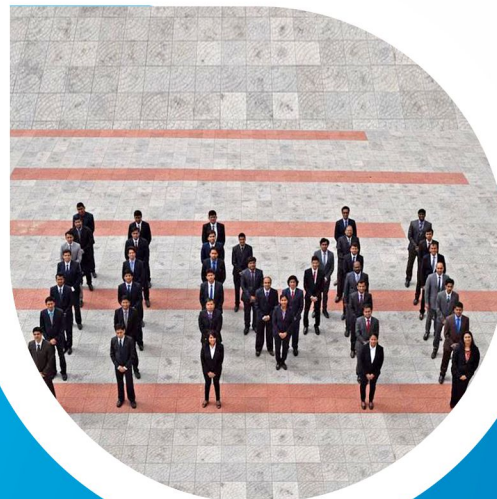

#### Application Procedure

1. Nomination by the exchange partner school.
2. Send students application forms with the required documents (scanned copy in PDF will be accepted).

#### Required Documents

- Copy of passport valid for the duration of exchange term and additional 6 months from the planned date of return post completion of the term at IIMI and Indian VISA for students issued by Govt. of India.
- Student health insurance for minimum INR 2,00,000 (cash basis)
- Application form
- Passport size photograph
- Brief resume
- Latest transcript from the school

## Credit and Grading System

Credit	The concept of credit is used to compute the workload of a course. As a general rule, a four-credit course requires a commitment of about 100 hours from the participant of which is 25 hours are to be spent in the classroom (usually 20 sessions of 75 minutes each) and the balance to be utilized for preparation & assignments. The courses carry one, two, three & four-credits.

## Other Information

**Cost of the Programme:** As a part of student exchange agreement, incoming exchange students are exempted from tuition fees at IIM Indore. However, exchange students are required to pay hostel and miscellaneous charges for their on-campus housing at IIM Indore. Following is the breakup of Institutional Fees for incoming exchange students at IIM Indore:

### Fees for One Term

\*Miscellaneous Fee includes course material, access to lectures, computing facilities, library, medical dispensary facility etc. Medical facility includes a dispensary at the institute where first-aid and other routine medical treatment is given. Basic medicines would be provided in the dispensary. For other drugs, doctors will give prescription, which participants have to buy on their own.

\*\* To be refunded in cash at the end of the term after deducting dues, if any.

It is responsibility of students to collect their caution money a day before their departure; else, the transfer will be conducted through the bank with applicable transaction charges deducted, to be borne by the student.

\*\*\* Any revision to the fee will be notified.

**NOTE:** Student should have a medical insurance of their own in order to meet any hospitalization expenses. These fees can be paid either by bank transfer or through credit card/debit card or cash deposit in the campus branch of State Bank of India. The fees are required to be paid on or before registration.

## Academic Infrastructure:

Apart from the best standard classrooms, IIM Indore boasts the presence of facilities such as swimming pool, squash court, lawn tennis court etc. in the sports complex. Hostels are allotted to exchange students and mess services are also available apart from 7+ food joints on campus. The presence of medical centre and SBI banking facilities make the campus life a wholesome environment.

## Student Exchange Committee:

The student body ensures making the exchange programme a wholesome amalgamation for Exchange students. From being the first Point of Contact (POC) for incoming students, the committee conducts orientation in collaboration with International Relations Office (IRO), welcome dinner, cultural sensitization events such as Bon Appetite, mixed sports events and much more!

## Personal Expenses

There are some other expenses, which exchange students would normally incur during their stay at IIM Indore. The details of a few such common expenses are as follows:

- Rent for cab is around Rs. 1250 for a 4 seater cab. It is Rs. 2500 for an 8 seater cab. This rent for a round trip distance travelled up to 40 km over a period of 4 hrs. Extra charges are incurred for longer distances & time period.
- Dinner at local restaurant: Rs. 500-1000 per person (Approx).
- Mobile Phone charges: Rs. 450/SIM Card + Telephone usage charges.
- Other expenses could include expenses on daily use commodities bought by exchange students.
